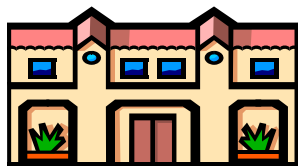
2012 Committee Opportunities

Affordable/Fair Housing:

Works with GAR, NAR and local officials to encourage REALTORS® to become interested and active in the housing needs of the community. This committee also works with the Education Committee to develop educational and training courses for REALTORS® on the duties, obligations and rights of REALTORS® under the Fair Housing Laws.

Commercial Council:

Addresses the specific needs of Commercial/Investment REALTORS®. Supports the professional practice of its members and promotes the views of its members on governmental, legislative and regulatory matters. **There is a yearly membership fee to join this committee.**

Community Service:

Keeps REALTORS® active in service to their community by coordinating/participating in a variety of projects throughout the year. This committee also works with the Keep Macon/Bibb Beautiful Commission in encouraging REALTORS® to be active in the beautification of Macon/Bibb County.
